³ Our potential supplier, Borderlink (a radio-mast based system), quotes a 30 Mbps speed connection for £42 per month inc VAT (as of May 2021). PACT is considering funding the installation of one or more masts as part of this network to reach areas of our community that are currently poorly served by any existing network internet providers. Before we fund the installation of a mast, we need a good indication of likelihood that at least 10 properties will sign up. Any less that this, and the mast will not be financially viable and it is unlikely that we will convince the supplier to accept our funding to do this.
